Second, I can inform a coach, parent, or team captain. Third, I can file an official written report to the Board of Directors. Lastly, I can report anonymously if I feel uncomfortable speaking out. 3. I understand that inappropriate intimacy, bullying, hazing, intimidation, racist behavior, sexual harassment, microaggressions, assault, vandalism, criminal activity and immoral conduct will not be tolerated. I agree to not only avoid these actions myself, but to report such actions to a coach, parent, team captain, or anonymously.

- 4. I agree that any drug or alcohol use could mean immediate and permanent dismissal from the Vashon Island Rowing Club. Costs will not be refunded for such actions.
- 5. I will not steal at any time or place. I will report such actions if I witness them. I will be respectful of people's possessions.
- 6. I will listen and follow all instructions from coaches, parents, and team captains.
- 7. I will attend all practices and events, unless given permission from the Head Coach. I will give at least one day's notice if I am to be absent.
- 8. I will treat all equipment belonging to Vashon Island Rowing Club as I am trained to do. I understand that any other behavior could cost me the privilege of using the equipment.
- 9. I understand that if I violate any of these rules at a regatta, it could jeopardize the entire team's participation.
